“The Vision of the Vancouver Port Authority and How this affects Alberta Industry”

When Alberta coal, agricultural products, fertilizers and petro-chemicals move to Pacific Rim markets, they move through the Port of Vancouver. It is not only Canada's largest and most diversified port, but a vital component of the infrastructure on which Alberta industry depends. And it directly supports more than 3,500 jobs in this province.

Both tremendous opportunities and challenges lie before the Port of Vancouver today. Container traffic through the port set a new record in 2002, underscoring the increasingly urgent need for further infrastructure development. Such development, however, depends on improved access to capital on the part of ports – an issue that is a focal point of an ongoing legislative review.

Captain Gordon Houston, President and Chief Executive Officer, will overview the Vancouver Port Authorities' vision for growth in the years ahead – growth in which the Alberta business community will be a key partner. He will also describe some of its current objectives for legislative change.
